> Report and Response to Noto Peninsula Earthquake Damage (7) - Volunteer Recruitment -

+Peace to you.

The other day, through "Report and Response (6)", I informed you of the current situation.

Today, I would like to report on the current situation and make a request for volunteers.

Currently (from May 13 to May 23), volunteer activities are suspended.

We are taking a preparatory period for the next phase (phase 2) of our activities due to changes in the local situation and the readiness to receive volunteers.

As for the local situation, infrastructure is gradually being restored and temporary housing is being built. The content and scope of activities are expanding, and the acceptance system is being put in place. The general framework for recruiting volunteers in the future is as follows;

1. The scope of activities is Nanao City, the surrounding area, and Wajima City. As the scope of activities expands, we are looking for volunteers who are not limited to the existing conditions (e.g., those who can drive a light truck).

2. Volunteer activities will resume on May 24 (Fri.), once a week from Friday to Sunday.

Please apply once a week, from Friday to Sunday, for 3 days and 2 nights. (One-night stays are not accepted.)

3. From this time on, only groups/groups will be able to accept high school students. Currently, we are only accepting groups from Tuesday to Thursday.

4. The accommodation for general volunteers is basically at the Nanao base (church) for both men and women, and at the Hakui base (church) for groups and organizations.
